DevelopING Tailored comprEhensive services for young migRAnts

INTEGRA (**DevelopING Tailored comprEhensive services for younG migRAnts**) commenced in November 2019, and is funded by the Erasmus+ Programme, under the Capacity Building in the field of Higher Education action. It aims to introduce an innovative methodology to four South Asian HEIs, which will facilitate young refugees/migrants overcome obstacles they might face in accessing formal education and receiving psychosocial support, while equipping them with the necessary skillset to help them better integrate in their host countries.

INTEGRA Info Days
